Access to Ritsumeikan University

- 20-minute walk to Ritsumeikan Univ.
- or
- 5-minute bus ride (Kyoto City Bus No. 53)
*2 stops from IH Taishogun

Room & Facilities

Short Program Rooms: 12 rooms (up to 4 persons)

Equipment and furnishings: 1 desk with 2 chairs, 2 stools, 2 bunk beds with curtain, hanging rail and clothes hangers, curtains, air conditioner, lighting

*Basically, the rooms will be used by multiple people, and the room assignments will be decided by the university.



1. Short Program Room w. bunk beds for 4 persons and furnishings
2. Bunk Bed
3. Laundry: 1 machine for each gender
4. Shower booth: 2 booths for each gender
5. Common space
6. Security box
7. Kitchen space (Common)
8. Microwave & Electric Kettle & Stock Box for each rooms
9. Kitchenware

Items you have to bring

*Since it is not a hotel, there are items you have to bring, rules to follow, and duties to rotate. Please apply for the dormitory with an understanding of these requirements.

*You can purchase laundry detergent or towels at the nearest shopping center.



- 1) **Facial and hair cleansing products:** Bring your preferred toiletries, including face wash and shampoo.
- 2) **Laundry detergent:** You'll need this for personal laundry.
- 3) **Towels:** Pack sufficient towels for your stay, as they may not be supplied.
- 4) **Hairdryer:** Ensure it's compatible with Japanese voltage (100V) and plug type A.
- 5) **Slippers or flip-flops:** Bare feet inside the facility is prohibited, so please bring appropriate indoor shoes.
- 6) **Kitchenware:** While the kitchen is equipped with basic items like cups, plates, and cooking utensils, you may bring additional items if you have specific preferences.
